An Essential Technical Guide for Perfect Tribute Delivery

The quality of your photos, videos, and other media directly shapes the beauty of your final tribute. This guide contains everything you need to know to ensure your cherished memories reach their full potential and play flawlessly on the day. Please share these details with anyone helping to provide these resources.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN: ONE SIMPLE STEP

For the smoothest tribute creation process, gather all of your media assets on one device. This could be a computer, tablet, or even a phone—just one central location where everything lives. You can also:

- Nominate a co-contributor to help upload
- Talk to us about delivering files in other ways if needed

THE GOLDEN RULE: ALWAYS SEND ORIGINALS

Always send us the original, highest-quality version from your device—not a compressed version that's been texted or emailed.

Why this matters: Files shared via text, email, or social media are typically downsized so severely they become unusable in a high-quality video tribute. The photo that looks fine on your phone screen may be too small and pixelated for a 4K cinematic experience.

Remember: This could be the one and only chance you have to make your photos bigger, clearer, and better than they have ever been. Your restored digital copies can be shared infinitely and remain part of your family legacy for centuries to come.

PART 1: PROVIDING YOUR PHOTOS

The Short Version

- Format: JPG or PNG files
- Size: Minimum 150 KB, maximum 10 MB per file
- Resolution: Higher is better

SCANNING TIPS (THE GOLD STANDARD)

If possible, use a flatbed scanner at 600 DPI (dots per inch) or higher. This captures every detail our AI and artists can work with.

How to scan properly:

1. Scan, don't photograph – A scanner captures flat, even light with no distortion
2. Clean gently – Wipe dust from photos and scanner glass with a soft cloth
3. Save as highest quality JPG – Choose maximum quality settings

If you can't access a scanner, it's easy to find a print and copy centre near you - and it's absolutely worth the trip.

PHOTOGRAPHING PRINTS (IF SCANNING ISN'T POSSIBLE)

There are dedicated phone apps such as Photomyne and Google PhotoScan that work reasonably well as a last resort. However, glare, shadows, and perspective distortion can make restoration significantly more difficult.

If you must photograph a photo, follow these guidelines:

1. Find good light – Place the photo on a flat surface in bright, even, natural light (avoid direct sun, flash, and shadows)
2. Get parallel – Hold your phone/camera directly above and perfectly parallel to the photo
3. Fill the frame – Make sure the photo fills as much of the image as possible
4. Check focus – Tap the screen to ensure the photo is sharp before capturing

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

When you upload photos to your portal, you'll be able to:

- Add notes about each image (things to highlight, things to avoid)
- Select your Top 10 favourite photos
- Choose ONE special image for the primary holding screen
- Request specific enhancements (colorization, animation, etc.) based on your package

PART 2: PROVIDING VIDEOS

FORMATS & ORIENTATION

We can incorporate short video clips into your tribute to add movement and emotion.

Preferred Formats:

- MP4 or MOV files
- Using the H.264 codec (the standard for high-quality video)

THE CRITICAL RULE: LANDSCAPE ORIENTATION

Landscape orientation (horizontal) is ALWAYS superior for widescreen TVs and projectors. Whenever possible, always film in LANDSCAPE mode. This means holding your phone sideways so the video is wider than it is tall.

Why this matters:

- Portrait (vertical) videos appear with large black bars on the sides of a TV or projector
- The image becomes dramatically smaller and loses impact
- The viewing experience feels awkward and amateur

What if you only have portrait videos?

We can reformat portrait videos, but this is a manual, time-intensive process that may incur an additional editing fee. When in doubt, film landscape!

PART 3: OTHER MEDIA ASSETS

AUDIO RECORDINGS

Do you have:

- A recording of their voice?
- A favourite piece of music they loved?
- An audio message from a loved one?

Upload MP3, M4A, or WAV files. Let us know in your notes how you'd like these incorporated.

DOCUMENTS & LETTERS

- PDFs of handwritten letters
- Scanned certificates or awards
- Poems or readings they loved

These can add beautiful context and depth to your tribute story.
