A Guide for the Legal Use of Music in Video Tributes

In today's world of instant digital sharing, what seems simple - using a favourite song in a video tribute - has become one of the most legally complex issues facing families and professionals alike. At Timeless Tributes, we navigate this landscape daily so you don't have to. In the past, DVD and BluRay tributes complied with the OneMusic License agreement in Australia and were not at risk of licensing violations because the burnt discs were for private use and, therefore, not easily distributed like content is today.

This guide explains why we approach music the way we do, and how our system protects everyone involved while delivering emotionally resonant tributes.

A Quick Synopsis of 5 main choices:

1. Break the law and risk serious penalties.
2. Pay exorbitant licensing fees and wait months for approval
3. Create a highly customised AI-generated soundtrack for your tribute
4. Hire professional musicians to record a cover version of your favourite songs
5. Include the AI soundtrack for sharing later, but play your favourite songs independently at the premiere under the OneMusic License.

Timeless Tributes has been designed around option 5, with plans to explore further options in the future. To protect all parties, we create a legally compliant version with a customised AI generated soundtrack with the additional option of playing your favourite songs at the premiere as long as your Timeless Tribute is never "synchronized" with a licensed piece of music. The Core Problem: Two Rights, One Song

Every commercially recorded song involves two separate copyrights:

1. The Composition (the music and lyrics)
 - Owned by the songwriter(s) and their publisher(s)
 - Licensed through organizations like APRA AMCOS in Australia
2. The Sound Recording (the specific performance)
 - Owned by the recording artist and their record label
 - Licensed through organizations like PPCA in Australia

To legally include a specific song in your video tribute for sharing, you need permission from BOTH rights holders. This is called a **Synchronization License**.

The Social Media Trap

Platforms like YouTube, Facebook, and Instagram have automated systems (Content ID) that detect copyrighted music. When you upload a video containing unlicensed music, the platform may:

- Block the video entirely (in some or all countries)
- Remove the audio (leaving silence)
- Place ads on the video (with revenue going to the rights holder)
- Issue copyright strikes against your account

This is not theoretical. It happens daily. A tribute meant for sharing with distant family can disappear or become unwatchable because of these automated systems.

The Scale of Licensing Costs

To understand why licensing commercial music isn't simple or cheap, consider these real examples:

- Microsoft reportedly paid \$8 million USD in 1995 to license The Rolling Stones' "Start Me Up" for Windows 95
- Apple pays an estimated \$1-2 million USD for each U2 song used in commercials
- Even for a small business, licensing a major hit song for online use typically starts at \$10,000-\$50,000 AUD and can take 4-16 weeks to secure, and there is no guarantee of approval

Who Bears the Legal Risk?

If unlicensed music is used improperly, multiple parties face liability:

Party	Potential Risks
Your Family	Takedown notices, blocked videos, copyright strikes on personal accounts
Funeral Directors	Breach of their OneMusic licence, damage to professional reputation
Venues	Legal action from rights holders for unauthorized public performance
Timeless Tributes	Copyright infringement lawsuits, business termination, permanent brand damage
